- a. Proposed website and motto changes Mark Wieting Several items were discussed with respect to to club's motto, website and general messaging. The initial suggestion was to offer a \$250 scholarship to each of two members, provided adequate funding is available. The criteria for selection would need to be determined. The discussion then evolved to an alternative of paying more professional type individuals for Zoom presentations (training and demo) that would benefit all members instead of just two. In the past, we were paying approximately \$300 per presentation. If funding permits, we may want to consider a larger budget for this type of program going forward.
