

Rocking Horse—Operation Sheet

Material: 3/4" poplar, close grain pine, or equivalent

Equipment Required: Bandsaw or Scroll saw, sandpaper & glue

Finish: None required, leave as bare

Notation: This is a two (2) piece assembly. One piece is the horse and the other is a rocker.

Operations:

1. Trace horse pattern to wood. Also rocker when made separately. Orient wood grain vertically for strength.
2. Cut out horse and rocker pieces
3. Sand all sharp edges.
4. As this is a two piece assembly you will have to trim the legs of the horse to match the arc of the rocker. Make and fit operation.
5. Glue rocker to horse and clamp.
6. Test rocking capability. You may have to do some final sanding to insure the horse rocks smoothly.

Stand back and enjoy your craftsmanship.
